### Important Information About Classes:

#### Painting

**4:00-5:00**

**Open to Grades: Kindergarten – 8<sup>th</sup> / \$80 per student**

Please come and join Mr. Clay & friends for an hour of creative expression as we explore the world of painting. Each week students will discover new materials, techniques, and theories which will help build on their artistic knowledge. Students will have an opportunity to complete a painting each class session which they will be able to take home to share with friends and family. All materials and a light snack will be provided.

#### Yoga Club

Ms. Lindy is an Integrative Theatre and Healing Arts Practitioner who received her B.A. in Theatre from Keene State College, and M.A in Counseling Psychology with a concentration in Drama Therapy. In this class students will engage in dynamic improv games and fun scene-work which will, in turn, heighten self-awareness, self-regulation, inspiration, empathy and interpersonal skills. The quarter will end with a final performance showcase for families!

## The NC Naturalist

4:00-5:30

Grades: 2<sup>nd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> / \$35 per student

Break out your mud boots! This class will be exploring the ArtSpace campus grounds in the wilds on the edge of creek! Ms. Jesse is a conservationist and behavioral specialist who has been leading groups of young adults in conservation efforts. Students in this class will learn names of different plants and animals, take a deeper look into the workings of the natural world around us. Students will even make their own plant press and herbarium, create decorative labels for native and invasive plant species near the creek, as well as learn some of the principles of scientific drawings. This course is designed to give participants the knowledge and skills needed to identify plants native and non-native to the Blue Ridge ecological system surrounding ArtSpace. We'll have snack together at the outdoor classroom before setting off on our daily journey into learning.

## Ukulele Club

ArtSpace's 4<sup>th</sup> grade teacher, Ms. Tonya, is excited to teach this class to students after school who love, or have interest in, the ukulele. Ms. Tonya will teach beginners the basic chords to get started, and experienced players will be in a group that will choose songs to learn together to advance skills and learn harder chords and strumming techniques.
