4 weeks: 9/23, 9/30, 10/7, 10/14 (Possible make-up day: 10/28)

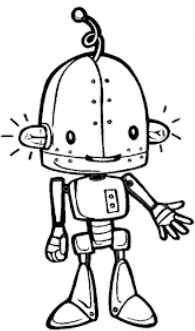
Beginner Ukulele
